Although Nepal is the poorest nation in Asia, it is one of the richest countries in the world in terms of biodiversity due to its unique geographical position and altitude variation. It is the country of Mount Everest, the birth place of Lord Buddha, with 60 ethnic groups, 92 spoken languages, 3000 temples, 1200 monasteries and lamaseries, 10 world heritage sites and many more. These qualities make Nepal a unique place giving high potentialities for the growth of its tourism industry

About Tribhuvan University

Tribhuvan University (TU) is the first national institution of higher education in Nepal. It was established in 1959. The Central Administrative Office and the Central Campus of the university are located on the north eastern facade of Kirtipur, an ancient and small town located five kilometers away from Kathmandu city center. TU marked its golden jubilee in the year 2009 organizing various programs. In the 52nd year of its establishment, the university family remains committed and dedicated to making it a source and center of quality education to set up a culture of learning in the country and to promote the notion of national and global peace and harmony. In the current academic session (2012-2013), there are 143,899 students study in 60 constituent campuses and 38 central departments of Tribhuvan University all across Nepal. Another 229,947 students study in 826 affiliated colleges.
